

AVALON DEVELOPMENT CORP.

PROSPECT 2012-2

Commodities: Gold and silver, possible byproduct tungsten, bismuth and tellurium

Access: Tidewater, limited roads, abundant ATV trails

Infrastructure: Close to regional infrastructure

History: +1,000,000 oz placer gold produced, +500,000 ounces of lode gold resources in district, recent drilling on southern side of district, no modern exploration or drilling on northern half of the district.

Resources: None on this prospect, +500,000 ounce lode gold resources in district

Geology: Poly-metamorphosed pelitic and calcareous schist with Cretaceous intrusives, regional high angle and low-angle structures important, metal zoning around gneiss dome complex previously unrecognized.

Mineralization: Gold mineralization appears to be genetically, temporally and chemically identical to several +1 Moz. intrusive related gold deposits in the Tintina Gold Belt

Recent Exploration: Previously unrecognized district scale mineral zonation suggests presence of large areas of prospective but unexplored terrain.

Land and Competitors: Open State lands and Alaska Native corporation lands, active claims in southern end of district, limited active claims in northern end.
